Early applications are strongly encouraged since applications received by **December 1, 2018 will be given priority consideration in filling the available spots. Late applications may result in a delayed timeline for processing, and will only be reviewed if spots are still available after the priority applications have been processed.*



SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

IN ORDER TO APPLY, A STUDENT MUST:

- Be a first-time freshman at UNLV in Fall 2019
- Be graduating with a 3.25 unweighed cumulative GPA or higher from Nevada Clark County high school prior to starting UNLV (verified during admissions)
- Demonstrate financial need either via Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the UNLV Alternative Need Determination Form
- Complete the Engelstad Scholars Application and successfully navigate the application process

IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THEIR ELIGIBILITY IN THE PROGRAM, A SCHOLAR MUST:

- Complete 50 hours of community service per semester (100 per year)
- Enroll and complete at least 12 credit hours every semester at UNLV
- Maintain 3.00 cumulative GPA or higher
- Complete the New Scholars Course during their first fall semester and attend Engelstad Scholar events throughout the academic year

The Engelstad Scholars Program was established by the Engelstad Family Foundation through an endowment of \$12.625 million to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in 2009, with the first set of scholars enrolled in 2010.

Students are placed with non-profit organizations to complete 100 hours of service each year. The scholarship awards \$2,500 per semester for up to eight consecutive semesters to scholars who maintain their scholarship eligibility.
