Many of you have inquired about the new state guidelines that require students to take a minimum of six classes in senior year if you are not meeting certain criteria.

One way to meet the requirement is to earn a minimum ACT score.
The score needed is 18 on the English portion and 22 on the Mathematics portion.

STATISTICS SHOW THAT STUDENTS WHO TAKE THE EXAM MORE THAN ONCE WILL GET BETTER RESULTS THE SECOND TIME

The ACT will be administered to all Juniors at Liberty High School on Tuesday, March 12, 2019.

ALL students are required to take the ACT with writing in order to graduate.

The following are reasons to do well on the ACT:

- (1) To be allowed to take less than 6 classes senior year if you have your credits.
- (2) To be eligible to take Math & English courses at college rather than remedial courses. Remedial courses are required if you have less than 18 on the English portion and less than 22 on the math portion.
