

APPLYING FOR SISTEM

Applications will be accepted until January 1, 2019 for the first program, and February 20, 2019 for the second program.

In order to apply for SISTEM, the applicant must be a high school student in Southern Nevada. Students should be committed to attending all the sessions.

Students who are successful in attending **every session** will receive a **certificate of completion** of the SISTEM program. Every time the student attends a session, their name will be put into a drawing for a prize that will be given out at the end of the program.

The application period will open December 10, 2018. Students wishing to apply for both programs **may do so at the same time or apply separately before each program's deadline**. This is a competitive application process and selection is not guaranteed.

Transportation is the responsibility of the student. If transportation is an issue, SISTEM will assist students as much as possible in obtaining transportation.
